Guidelines for submission of abstract are as follows:

- **The abstract should be prepared in word document (.doc or .docx file) using the Font–Times New Roman, Size-12.**
- **The abstract should contain Title, Authors, affiliation/s and Main body**
- **Title-** Title should be typed in bold and in sentence case, i.e., use a capital letter at the beginning of title only and no full stop at the end.
- **Authors**
 - Author names should be typed as – Surname & initials. (Example- Singhanian SA, Rao AB)
 - The name of the presenting author should be underlined. (Example- Singhanian SA, Rao AB)
 - The corresponding author should be indicated by * (Example- Singhanian SA, Rao AB*)
- **Affiliation/s (Addresses of Author/s)**
 - Affiliation should be typed in sentence case.
 - It must contain, Name of the department/school/College, Name of University, detail address with Pin code.
 - Email of corresponding author
- **Main body- The main body of abstract must contain**
 - Objective/s, Method/s, Results and Conclusion
 - The abstract body should be limited to **250 words only**.

Note:

- **Abstracts without results will not be accepted.**
- Abstracts if accepted, author/co-author has to register for the event, failing which presentation will not be permitted/included in the conference proceedings.

PROCESSING OF ABSTRACTS

Abstracts will be reviewed by a panel of referees prior to final acceptance by the Scientific Committee. The author would be informed regarding acceptance by 15th December 2017 by email.
